


NOVENA TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

About this Novena

The Pentecost Novena is the oldest Christian novena because Jesus himself asked His disciples to devote themselves to prayer nine days before the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. We read in the Bible of how the disciples "were constantly devoting themselves to prayer" (Acts 1:14).

Today we follow in the disciples' footsteps as we wait in our own 'upper room' and dedicate ourselves to nine days of prayer. We welcome with eager anticipation any gifts that the Holy Spirit intends to give us.

This Novena usually commences on the *Friday Before Ascension Sunday*, which is nine days before Pentecost Sunday. You may also pray this Novena at any time.

THE NOVENA TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

HOW TO PRAY THIS NOVENA EACH DAY

- 1. Begin the prayer by taking some time to **quiet your heart**, **slow your breathing** and **calm your mind**. Then, ask the Holy Spirit to make you **aware of His presence** as you open up to him leading your prayer.
- 1. Pray the consecration to the Holy Spirit as below.
- 1. Pray the prayer corresponding to the day of the novena (1-9).
- 1. Remain in silence for a moment and be open to what God might say to you.
- 1. Finish by saying one 'Our Father' as Jesus taught us and one 'Hail Mary' (see page 6).

ACT OF CONSECRATION TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

Holy Spirit, Paraclete, I consecrate myself to you. You can have my heart. Please fill it with the fire of your love. Let me learn your ways and know your truth. Make me aware of your gentle whisper in my heart so that I can always follow your promptings. Let me live in obedience to you and bless my entire household with the gift of faith. I am willing to receive whatever gifts you wish to give me.

I love you, Lord, and I wait with expectant faith for you to come upon me as at the first Pentecost.




